

What is the European Location Framework?

The European Location Framework is a unique gateway to harmonised pan-European maps, geographic and land information. It provides a single point of access for licensing data from official sources.

It is a practical implementation of INSPIRE and complements the activities of European national mapping, cadastral and land registry authorities. The European Location Framework will meet user needs whilst reducing costs, create new business opportunities and increase the reuse of public sector information.

What are the benefits?

- A single source of official, quality-assured data from Europe's national mapping, cadastral and land registry authorities.
- A single point of access for licensing data from multiple countries.
- Harmonised data delivered to a common and consistent specification.

What is the European Location Framework Project?

A package of pilot products and services to defined international standards will be available for application developers to test and develop solutions that meet market needs.
